- We will provide an on demand webinar on how to manage stress and anxiety in the face of a pandemic that will be able to be shared with employees and family members

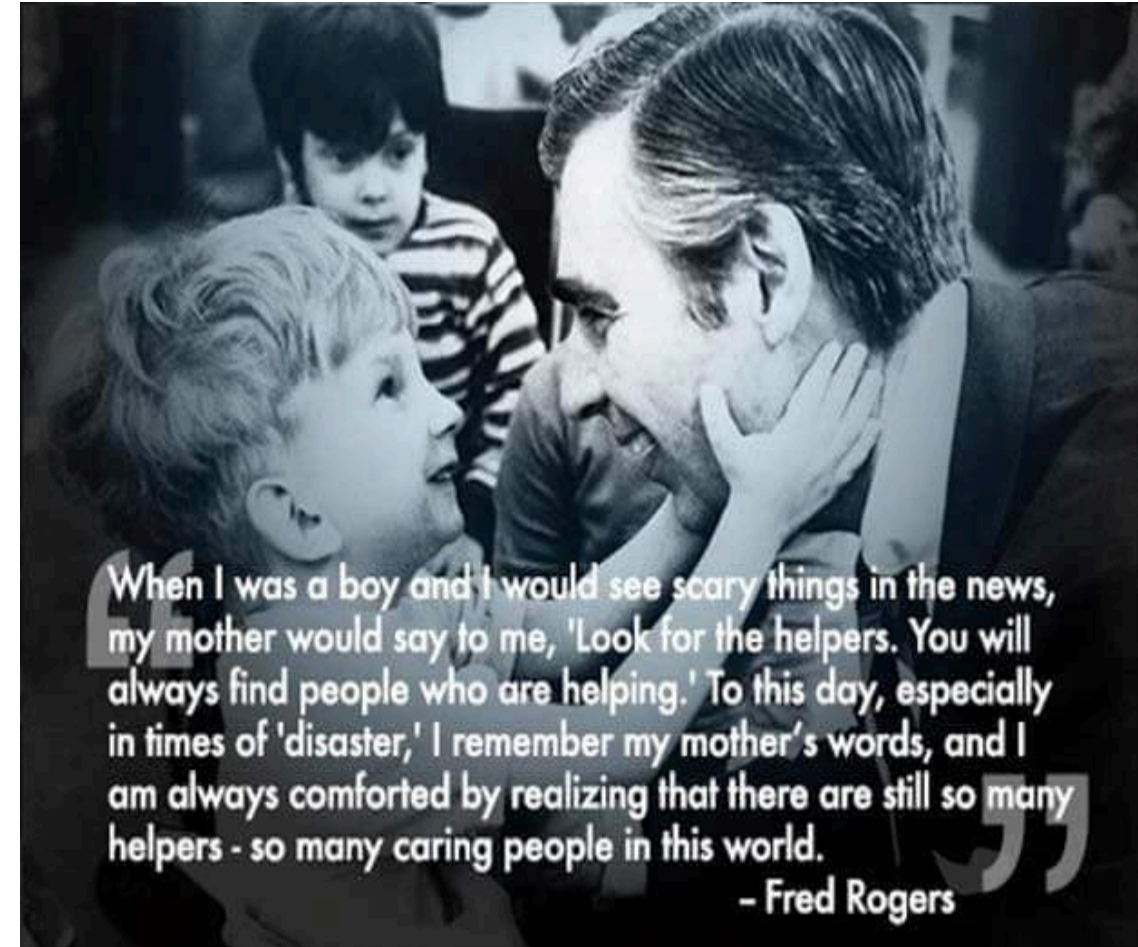
